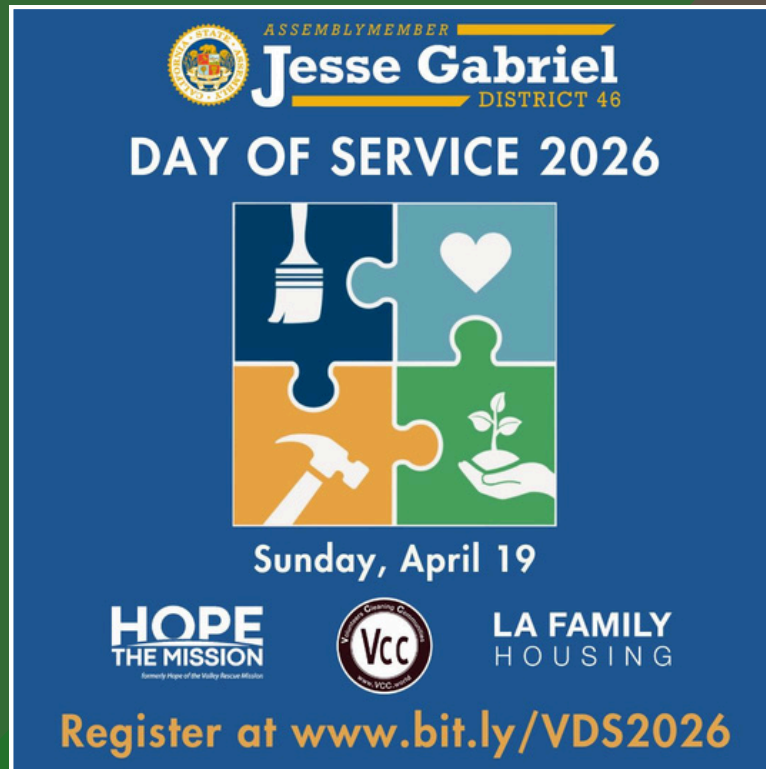
Golf Tournament Drives Community *Impact*

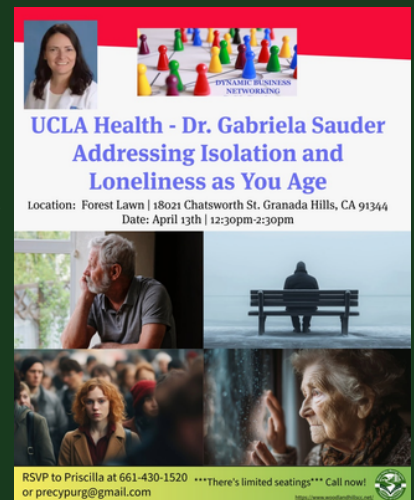
