



I sang in 4 performances including the Los Angeles National Cemetery for the Flag Placement where thousands of <u>Boy Scouts</u>, <u>Girl Scouts</u>, and <u>EAGLE</u> <u>SCOUTS</u> placed American flags on nearly 100,000 graves on Saturday as well as the Memorial Day ceremony, the American Legion Post 43 -Hollywood, CA Memorial Day service, and the grand finale of Los Angeles Fleet Week at the Battleship USS Iowa BB-61. I was proud to represent my country in singing the National Anthem for all 4 performances, America the Beautiful accompanied by my husband Jaime Roy, and God Bless America accompanied by Jeff Smith leading the The United States Army Band.

I express sincere gratitude to all of our military service members past and present, with a special thank you to my family who have served: my brother Mike Standridge (US Marine Corps), my sister Amber Jackie Standridge (US Coast Guard), my brother Johnny Standridge (US Navy), my cousin Asher Mobley who was able to attend today and will soon be deployed to the border (Army National Guard), my cousin Nick Mobley (US Navy), my Uncle Tom Mobley (US Navy), and my Uncle Sam Standridge (US Army). My Uncle Sam's journey as a POW who was able to return home gives me hope for our current POW's and MIA's, and these brave Americans are crucial to acknowledge and remember today. 10

I also want to express my deepest appreciation to <u>Glen Schecter</u> and <u>Chaplain Dov Cohen</u> for inviting me to be a part of such incredible programs, for your very moving speeches and leadership this weekend, and for your service.

I would like to share a few sentences from a speech yesterday by Major General Dr. David Smith who leads <u>Edwards Air Force Base</u>, which was one of the most impactful speeches I have ever heard and moved me and many others to tears, in the best way I can remember it...

"I once was on a flight next to a man who told me he was on the way to a walk for world peace. He lit up when he told me he planned to walk from Los Angeles to Seattle. He then asked me what I did and I told him, 'I am a B-52 Bombardier with the United States Air Force.' We didn't speak for much of the rest of the flight but I prayed to have the right words in the right moment. Toward the end of the flight, the man turned to me and said, 'I'm sorry if I offended you. It's clear we have very different objectives.' I said, 'Actually, our objectives are identical. You are willing to walk for our country and our freedoms, while the men and women in our armed forces are willing to die for them.'"






